Dear Canisius High School Parents and Guardians,

We pray that you and your family are well. This seems like a good time to write now that we have more than a month's experience under our belts and with the holidays on the horizon.

We are pleased that on a daily basis we have roughly 95% of our students present for in-school instruction. Faculty, staff and students continue to be attentive to our health and safety protocols. We believe that the motivation for our students' attentiveness emerges from their desire to be in school with their teachers and classmates.

Having said this, while we have health and safety protocols in place at school, we know we cannot manage our students outside of school. Please continue to stress with your sons the importance of maintaining physical distance, properly wearing face coverings, washing hands, staying home when sick, and complying with all health and safety measures.

As you and your families look to the holidays and any potential travel, it is important to remember that if you travel to a state on the NYS Department of Health's (NYS DOH) list of restricted states that your son will need to quarantine for fourteen (14) days. The period of quarantine begins on the day he returned to New York. We have no discretion regarding our implementation of NYS DOH policies.
