Freshmen: Freshmen are encouraged to begin studying for their final exams throughout the month of May. Teachers have posted study guides for finals in Schoology. Finish the year strong and congratulations on all of your hard work this year!

Sophomores: Sophomores have completed the Career Exploration course and now have access to SCOIR, the college information and admission platform they will use extensively in their junior and senior years. This will allow them to "Follow" colleges and gain valuable information about admission standards at various schools specifically for Canisius students.

Juniors: Juniors are encouraged to finish the year strong as this will be the last chance for them to impact the cumulative average colleges will be looking at when they review their applications in the fall.

Remember that students must register individually for the [SAT](#) and [ACT](#). The final SAT and ACT tests for this school year will be in June. The June 3 SAT registration deadline is May 4; June 10 ACT registration deadline is May 5.

On Tuesday, March 7 we held a Zoom workshop going over how to use the SCOIR college admission platform as a parent. We are asking for parents to complete the Release Authorization that allows us to send out materials to colleges. We also have a Parent Brag Sheet in the Surveys section of SCOIR that we ask parents to complete to assist us in writing your son's letter of recommendation.
