## **NEWS FROM THE GUIDANCE CENTER**

**Sophomores:** Sophomores have now received their Strong Interest Inventory career and college report in their Career Exploration classes. Mrs. Langworthy and Mrs. Moscovic reviewed the results of the students' reports during classes and provided students with detailed career information through the [O-Net](#) Career Information site provided by the U.S. Department of Labor. This website allows students to research the details about any career of their choosing, including projected job outlook and salary information in different parts of the country. Career Exploration classes will continue through the end of April and will include an introduction to SCOIR, the online platform used by Canisius to manage students' college search process.

**Juniors:** Juniors are encouraged to finish the year strong as this will be the last chance for them to impact the cumulative average colleges will be looking at when they review their applications in the fall.

Remember that students must register individually for the [SAT](#) and [ACT](#). The deadlines for the upcoming tests are as follows: May 6 SAT registration deadline is April 7, June 3 SAT registration deadline is May 4, June 10 ACT registration deadline is May 5.

On Tuesday, March 7 we held a Zoom workshop going over how to use the SCOIR college admission platform as a parent. We are asking for parents to complete the Release Authorization that allows us to send out materials to colleges. We also have a Parent Brag Sheet in the Surveys section of SCOIR that we ask parents to complete to assist us in writing your son's letter of recommendation. 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The Junior Awards Assembly and National Honor Society induction will take place on Tuesday, May 23. The deadline to apply for Junior Awards is March 31. Students who qualify for National Honor Society have received an application, which will be due on Monday, April 17.

**Seniors:** Please remember to send in copies of all acceptance and scholarship letters. This will be required in order to obtain your graduation tickets. Hard copies or electronic copies (e-mails/screenshots) should be given to your school counselor. Ms. Cathy Stokes will begin distribution of graduation tickets during the last two weeks of April. The national deadline to make your decision about where you will enroll and pay your deposit is May 1. If you have any questions about acceptances, applying for financial aid or choosing a college, please have your son meet with his counselor. Families are encouraged to contact colleges' financial aid departments to discuss options available to them or to appeal/review financial aid awards.
