# 2024-2025 COURSE SELECTION UNDERWAY

- During March students will be selecting courses for the 2024-2025 school year. Administrators
  and counselors are meeting with students to explain the course catalog and the course selection
  process.
- A parent signature is required for the course selection form to be considered complete.

- The 2024-2025 Course Catalog is available on Schoology. Please direct any questions about course selection to your son's counselor or to the Registrar, Mrs. Battin. Questions about course level placement should be directed to the Assistant Principal, Mrs. Whittington.
- Once the course verification process is complete (typically by May or early June) a student's
  course requests are considered <u>final</u>. All efforts will be made to schedule a student in his
  desired courses, <u>provided he meets the necessary prerequisites</u>. Nonetheless, students should
  be aware that some courses will have restricted enrollment, some classes may be cancelled due
  to low enrollment, and some combinations of course requests will be impossible to schedule
  because of conflicts.

# **NEWS FROM THE GUIDANCE CENTER**

<u>Freshmen:</u> Course selection forms for freshmen were due on February 16. Parent signatures are required on these forms. If you have not yet seen your student's form, please be sure to ask him about it or you may reach out to his counselor.

<u>Sophomores:</u> All sophomores have taken the Strong Interest Inventory during Career Exploration class. In the coming weeks, they will use their results to consider various career possibilities, learn more about career resources online and research a specific career of interest. Sophomores have also received their course selection forms, which are due to their counselor, with a parent signature, by Monday, March 11. Counselors will meet with each of their students to discuss their choices.

### Juniors:

- In College Planning class, students have learned about SAT/ACT testing, utilizing Khan Academy
  for test prep and the SCOIR college platform. Next topics include utilizing SCOIR in the college
  search, researching careers, creating resumés, the Common Application and requesting
  recommendations.
- All prospective college-bound athletes are invited to attend our annual seminar on athletic
  eligibility on Monday, March 18 during Gold period in the Brady Conference Room. NCAA
  Liaison, Dr. Veronica and Athletic Director, Mr. Mauro will present information for athletes on
  eligibility, recruiting and what coaches look for. Students in any sport who expect to play at the
  college level are invited to attend.
- Juniors have also all received their course selection forms, which are due to their counselor, with a parent signature, by Monday, March 4. Counselors will meet with each of their students to discuss their choices.
- \*PLEASE NOTE: All juniors and at least one parent/guardian must attend one of the Junior College Information Night programs being hosted during March and April. - Please remember to send in copies of acceptances as they are received. Hard copies or electronic copies (e-mails/screenshots) should be given to your school counselor. This information is required in order to receive your graduation tickets in May.
- Many colleges are extending their reply deadlines beyond May 1 in response to the significant delay in the processing of FAFSA financial aid information. Colleges should begin receiving this information from the Department of Education very soon, and will send out financial aid packages as quickly as they can. Please pay close attention to the communication you are receiving from colleges regarding this matter.
